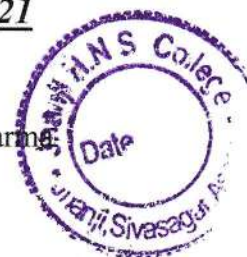


REPORT OF STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY 2020-21
