- 3. Write a comparative note on the status of women in Hindu and Buddhist religion and their changing position in early India.
- 4. Trace the development of women's education in India in the 19th century with special reference to the role of the Christian missionaries.
- 5. Examine the role of the women's organizations in creating public opinion regarding women's rights in the colonial period. How far was the Indian women's demand for franchise successful?
- 6. Do you agree that women in the Gandhian age played a more significant role in the Indian Freedom Struggle than in the pre-Gandhian phase? Explain.
- 7. Did patriarchal values play any role in determining the social status of women in medieval Assam? Explain.
- 8. How was the Assamese society influenced by the social reform movements of the 19th and early 20th century?
